I've come across a very good new Klingon fanzine called HEART OF GLORY, or HOG. It is edited by a group of five in Cincinnati, OH, and available from Bill Hupe, 918 Lamb Road, Mason, MI 48854-9554. Another is the QUIN-LAT, and IMPERIAL GEOGRAPHIC MAGAZINE, available from the same source. Unfortunately I don't know the prices just now, but it would be worth your time to enquire. They are great Klingon reading, and they invite submissions! Interested in playing Klingon Scrabble? A new board and pieces are available for \$23 plus \$2 shipping from Glen Proechel (see advertisement elsewhere in this issue.) A word of warning about James Van Hise, publisher of the BUDGET GUIDE TO THE KLINGONS and many other Trek books. This man invites submissions and promises payment, but he does not always pay off. A number of KSF members submitted material to this book, which he edited to suit himself, but it took a letter of enquiry from Capt. Katalyia to get any payment for them. I was not so fortunate, as I submitted material, specifically the WORLD OF KIAHZ to him directly. I not only did not get the promised payment or a contributor's copy, but was not even given credit for my work. He is soliciting submissions for several more Trek books now. Beware! NAME CHANGE OF BTL (FROM VIXIS.) It was decided by Mardan and I to change the name of this publication to reflect the new direction the club is taking. We are no longer a covert spying organisation, as can be gleaned from reading the RPG reports and are now much more upfront in our operations. I chose the name "Beyond the Lines" to demonstrate our new role, but keep in tune with what has happened before. If you

Hopefully, this new procedure should remove any chance of possible favouritism or unfair judgements , as ALL promotions above Lt Cmdr are moderated by the High Council. Please remember thoguh, these promotions are only imaginary and are simply a way of publicly saying thank you to members who contribute so much to the running of the club. To be promoted above Lt Cmdr, youo should be helping the club in a major way. i.e. Command a Sector or one of the large divisions and be communicating strongly. All new sector/ division commanders

Club Projects

KSF CLAN HISTORIES - Katalyia K'Tore-Jiraal (GSA Sector 3). Do your line justice and write its history. Send for Katalyia's clan history as an example. (A number of these appear in the Budget Guide to the Klingons.

WORLDS OF THE KLINGON EMPIRE - Create your Homeworld, or a section thereof, a new Klingon world, (perhaps just conquered!) Describe geographical features, cities, inhabitants, exports, flora and fauna, whatever you imagine. Maps would be most beneficial. Fleet Admiral K'Zhen Zu-Merz. (GSA Command)

KLINGON FAUNA AND FLORA - Describe, draw animals, insects, birds, fish, and plant life of Klingon worlds. Ask Adm. K'Zhen Zu-Merz for examples and form to follow.

KAHLESS' BOOK OF TASTELESS JOKES: Got any? Or convert jokes or anecdotes you like into Klingon jokes. Make fun of Romulans, Ferengi, Pakleds, etc. Make funny sketches, too! Send them to Adm. K'Zhen.

What is essential in being a Klingon?

1. A good sense of humour, to combat non-comprehending family and friends, and to cope with the inevitable "Cling onto what?" jokes. If you can't laugh at yourself, you may find being a Klingon a painful experience.
2. Inventiveness and Creativity. To create an alternative reality, whether in writing or artwork takes creativity and inventiveness on a grand scale. In England, Klingons are expected by other Trekker groups to be the life and soul of the party, and to come up with fresh surprises. Some of these take quite a bit of planning, though we are always open to the spontaneous gesture!
3. Ingenuity, especially if you get into costuming and model making. Most of us have had to learn by doing, and making many mistakes along the way.
4. Co-operation and sharing. By sharing ideas and inspirations, together we create an empire which is believable. By co-operating, sharing costumes, helping with makeup etc, we can enable as many as possible to enjoy the Klingon experience.
5. Last, but by no means least, pride to appear in public as a Klingon. Admittedly this is probably easier in England where there is a strong tradition of ignoring eccentricities. Thus you can catch a bus, go into a pub, a burger bar or amusement centre in full costume.

The Sisterhood were well represented at this convention, with Mardan being the sole male representative of the KSF. By the end of the weekend he reckoned that he had suffered quite enough to see him through several rites of Ascension! While still in Germany, he had sent us all photos of himself as a Blonde Klingon Warrior. Of course, we had all taken one look and said to ourselves "Goldilocks!". So for his first convention with the sisterhood, we had entered him in the Fancy Dress competition as the main character in a Koldilocks and the Three K'bears Sketch. We had made him a frilly dress in ghastly clashing shades of pink, and even brought balloons to give him the required Klingon Cleavage. Showing surprising resourcefulness for a marine, he claimed his mum lost his blonde hairpiece, but this would not save him. Immediately we rang Vixis who was not coming till Saturday, the day of the Competition, and asked her to bring a spare blonde headpiece with her.

The Winners of the Fancy Dress Competition were the more serious entries, but we gave everyone the biggest laugh. Finding himself with no means of escape, Mardan vamped it up beautifully. I came on as the aggrieved K'dad, followed by Vixis as K'mum.

Then came T'uhlor as K'baby, throwing a temper Tantrum and getting the sympathy vote. Mardan ad-libbed beautifully as one would expect from the Head of GSE! After the fancy dress came the Ceilidh where some of us were seen dancing the Gay Gordons, in Full Klingon Costume. Then came the highlight of the evening, the Klingon Party. This was a riot, with the usual tribble fight and round of nuq'IH salutes. All the kilted Scottish Klingons had their Uniform checked to ensure their equipment was in place, and the drink flowed freely. Again, Mardan proved himself, not only staying to the end of the Party (about 4 AM) but appearing at Breakfast at 8 AM the following morning - and even being able to eat it!

One of the highlights of the Sunday was the Klingon Opera. We knew from Zo'Annis and the other Scottish friends how much work had gone into this, so we were looking forward to seeing it. We were amazed to find that we were to be in it, as Standard Bearers. We arrived fully costumed and were made up at the time given for the Dress rehearsal but they weren't ready for us and we went to wait in the Hotel Lobby. Unknown to us, a thief had been spotted trying the room doors - not a wise thing to do when there are Klingons around, so the police were taking statements etc., from the main cast members while we were wondering when the dress rehearsal was due to start.

Finally we had a brief rehearsal of walking on and having the banners handed to us, and then it was time for the show. We led the procession and took up our places and the performance proper began. Vixis was standing right in front of one of the smoke machines so she disappeared from sight several times during the performance. T'uhlor was recovering from a bad cold anyway, and turned a interesting shade of purple as she tried to stop herself from

coughing. There was a lot of fighting, which kept the audience happy, but which put Kara and me in some danger of being trampled underfoot, as they had never done this with Standard Bearers in Position. Zo'Annis did her bit in a very professional manner. Only Mardan was literally above it all, standing on a Platform above all of us with his banner. I must say it all went very well and was a great hit.

The evening ended with the Disco. Mardan, in full costume, was doing his best John Travolta impression - well it was either that or he was practising his unarmed combat exercises. Vixis had changed into the most unbelievable skin tight black PVC outfit which captured everyone's attention, but then, she does have the figure for it. Altogether Scotland maintained its reputation for putting on fun conventions. We all had a great time.

Your First Convention

Conventions are, or should be, fun. Some people have never been and are apprehensive about what to expect, so here are some guidelines for those first timers.


1. Once you have checked in at the hotel, you will likely be wise to go out shopping and buy in supplies of food and drink. Both are likely to be expensive in the hotel. While shopping, look out for Burger or Pizza places as these are where you are likely to have any hot meals.
2. Have a Big Breakfast. This is going to be your main meal of the day and you are not likely to eat again till late afternoon or early evening so you need a substantial meal to keep you going.
3. Be ready to chat to everyone you meet. Don't wait to be approached - introduce yourself. IF they are not in costume, ask them what they are - Feddy, Rom, Klingon or whatever.

(Editor note- You will NEVER have to ask if someone is a KLINGON!) They'll freely tell you and as you chat to various groups, you'll find folk you get on with. Be ready to join in activities they get up to. This is the main part of being at a convention.

4. There may well be videos you want to see, but do not fill your day with video shows, guest talks and autograph sessions unless you really want to be on your own.
5. If you have not met anybody during the day, go to the disco and get out on the dance floor. It doesn't matter if you have the co-ordination of a Stick insect - you could set the trend! You'll always find someone to dance with. Don't just prop up the bar drinking by yourself. IF you do just want to drink, see if you can sit at a table with others and join in the talking.
6. Many Conventions have a first timers party. Go to it if you haven't yet joined up with a group.
7. Don't wait to be invited to parties. IF you hear of one happening and you feel in the party mood, go along, preferably with a bottle of your favourite drink. A very few parties are 'Ticket Only', the rest will be happy to see you.
8. If you are walking down a hotel corridor and see an open door and hear voices and laughter, it is fine to pop your head around the door to see what is going on. It could happen to be an impromptu party and they'll be happy to let you join in. IF not, they'll just tell you to go away, usually in a good natured manner.
9. Above all, remember that a convention is what you make it. If you want to have a good time, it is up to you to join in. If you don't, people will not run after you (Editor - Unless you are Female, Blonde haired, blue eyed, etc... in which case I'm sure one of us males will.) They will assume that you want to be left alone.

TRIBBLES

It is a commonly held galactic misconception that Klingons "hate" Tribbles in much the same way that they might hate an enemy, and that, conversely, tribbles "hate" Klingons equally so.

To prove this supposed fact, Starfleet service videos are often shown as evidence, these depicting Klingons cringing away from Tribble specimens, and the animal, for its part, squeaking loudly in apparent dismay when placed in close proximity to one of the Imperial race. Unfortunately, though the vids are correct enough in context, the standard Federation interpretation is quite misleading.

In reality, to say that Klingons hate tribbles would be analogous to saying that Humans hate cobras, poison oak and / or arsenic. In truth, each species has a toxic or allergic reaction to the thing in question, not a hatred, though to be fair to the outworlders, this specific vulnerability is not one the Empire was quick to publicise, for obvious reasons.

Allergic reactions are universal among the Imperial race, and range from moderate allergy symptoms such as sneezing and skin rashes from limited exposure, to severe breathing asthma-like difficulties and high blood pressure from moderate exposure, to anaphylactic shock and death in extreme cases with prolonged exposure. This prognosis in each case depends upon a number of factors including age and general health of the patient, degree and type of exposure, availability of antidote and when it is administered, and finally susceptibility to tribble toxin. Fusions, of any type, as one might expect, have less reaction than do Imperials, and the more fusion the blood, the less the reaction.

As many Humans have noticed, tribbles seem to enjoy the companionship of some species more than others, even purring in pleasure on physical contact with some. Although more research needs to be done, it appears as though the creatures actually have an emotionally symbiotic relationship with their hosts / owners and receive emotional gratification necessary to their existence by giving it in return. Since contact with the Klingon species is anything but pleasurable, such contact is actively avoided by the little animals who are acutely sensitive to the emotions they elicit. Whether this is an instinctive avoidance to pain reaction or is a conscious decision indicative of higher intelligence is debatable, and will require further testing.

History

Historically tribbles have played a surprisingly large and varied part in Klingon Culture.

On a military level, the Klingons known response to the life form had a great deal to do with the first use of human fusions in covert espionage and subsequently, fusion families into Klingon society. A Human Fusion who could safely handle tribbles to Federation satisfaction became invaluable in Klingon infiltration operations and were thus often given extremely sensitive missions that might otherwise have been denied them. With successful missions came recognition and rank, and with rank came power.

Socially, and at the opposite end of the acceptance spectrum before DNA typing became available, and even now for those to whom the tests are financially unfeasible, tribbles are used in many rural areas as a sort of crude field test to determine the racial purity of the potential bondmate. Much like the Terran fable of the

"The Princess and the Pea" , an Imperial line House, unsure of a potential mate's true lineage (and not wanting to start a war by asking embarrassing and possibly offensive questions) , might place a single small tribble in the bed of the one wishing to bond into the Linehouse. The worse the reaction, the more Imperial the blood. In families who highly prize their Imperial Bloodlines , especially those with older members who place little trust in the authenticity of modern tests (or the techs who administer them), the tribble tells the greater truth. No reaction, no bonding.


At one time , in southern Qo'noS , tribbles were used in official rites of Ascension , though the practice has lost favour in recent years , as a test of fortitude.

More common today is the use of tribbles in recreational activities such as "Tribble tossing" which has become quite popular in some areas , as has practice of arm wrestling with a live tribble held between the two opponents hands. What causes minor pain and irritation on light contact, quickly becomes excruciating if the tribble in the middle is compressed so that it's bodily fluids bathe the opponents hands and enter into open pores or tiny cuts. The winner of the game may not be the one who is strongest but rather the one able to withstand the most pain. The Game ends immediately if the tribble , so held, is inadvertently crushed, since both contenders will require emergency medical treatment and anti venom shots to survive.

Interestingly enough, though toxic, Tribble flesh is considered a delicacy in some circles , though is most often prepared in a sauce containing the antidote. When it is not, eating this dish is sometimes done in a ritual not unlike the Klingon Tea Ceremony.

T'Uhlor met up with Borg and found how to get drinks out of him. She claims that the mud bath was in fact a cesspit, so she went off on an assignation with a secret lover instead, armed with a big pot of marmalade! On the flight back to planet 69 she arranged a Red Alert at 3am to gather people for the reading of the will of Kara's late husband. It seems he left T'Uhlor all his money! K'hlagh became totally paranoid. He was courting Kara, but was worried that the captain and the entire crew could be plotting against her and that he would be involved in any fall-out

Vixis celebrated her return to the ship by going for a drink in Ten Backward, though she found some of Borg's rules a little strange. 
CAMPAIGN COORDINATION COMMAND RPG REPORT By Fleet Admiral K'Zhen epetai-Zu-Merz Hovjaj 9509.13 As of the above date, reports from the various divisions of the KSF have been received, as follows:

IMPERIAL INTELLIGENCE - (wo'InDab) Cmdr.

Arizhel, I.I./GSE commander: Lt. Ke'Reth successfully destroyed the cloning facility he had located. Another bird of prey diverted a patrolling Romulan ship and he and his crew were able to ensure that the base and all traces of Klingon genetic material were completely obliterated. The interrogation of the traitor M'Ress is complete and he finally agreed to reveal the name of his controller in return for the promise of death. It is Dav'had of the Kemor family, one of the three military advisors to Gowron on the High Council. This is beyond my competence to deal with and the information has been passed to Internal Intelligence. It appears he has a mistress who is another of the K'hest'n Duras females and his treason may have been inspired by her. Interestingly, M'Ress was one of the names revealed by the Romulan captured by Lt. Ke'Reth at the cloning facility. He was providing background documentation for most of the clones. We have accessed all computer records originating from M'Ress and have compiled a detailed list of where the clones are located and what identity they have assumed. One is now governor of Kul Dan which would make several of our colonies in that sector very vulnerable if it got into Romulan hands. As a governor, he is well guarded and no one would suspect him of being a Romulan tool. Ke'Reth has been sent there as a visiting ambassador and has recruited a trusted assistant to help him in exposing the governor. Details of the other clones have been sent to Global Security who will eliminate them. Lt. Vanar Kallisto reports her position on D'Vok is becoming difficult though her cover seems to be holding. The misinformation she has been producing has worked and the Romulans believe that D'Vok is likely to be the next target after Kamato, so they are wasting precious resources reinforcing the defences. She reported on a visit to the colony of a female named Riar who is believed to be very close to the Romulan Praetor. She has been asked to gather as much information as possible on this person and try to get herself attached to her staff. If she succeeds, this would take her to Romulus itself and to the centre of command there. Lt. Zo'Annis has been patrolling the colonies near the Romulan border disguised as a trader. She reported that the inhabitants of Gatt were unusually docile and found that they were being drugged to keep them in a trace-like condition. A medical team have been dispatched to race the source of this drug. She discovered a rebel ship in the vicinity and followed it back to THISISIT, where it disappeared. There are many renegade Klingons on this planet, and as you know it is our probable next target after Kamato. She has been doing scans and intends going down to the planet to see if there is a rebel military base there. The equipment she needs is being sent to her via a captured Ferengi ship so that she can maintain her cover as an itinerant trader. LCdr. K'Eherang Jiraal successfully fulfilled a mission for Cmdr. Krynn Krull to question a Romulan prisoner and confirm information learned through an agent in the Tal Shiar. Though the prisoner was reluctant, a threat of the mind-sifter brought results, and confirmed that the information was valid. This information was valuable in preparing our attack on Kamato. Cmdr. Krynn Krull reports: My sources reveal the



Romulans are building up along the neutral zine. When we attack the IKS they plan to come up behind us and attack from the rear or wait until we are fully committed and are damaged to come in and finish us off. As LCdr. K'Eherang has not reported in on this yet I am wondering if she has been captured. I will question other sources in the Star Empire. crew and I had just returned from our shakedown

cruise when I received an urgent summons from

Koryn who had returned to the base - against medical

advice. When I reached his location I met up with K'Lay

and together we captured Koryn's assailant which I suggest be

turned over to medical Ops command for analysis. K'Lay updated

me on the nanite problem and we both agreed that recent developments were of great concern - we now knew that both machines and people could be endangered by the nanites. Instead of returning to my quarters on K'Shona I made my way to the command centre - if one ship's systems were vulnerable to the nanite menace then so were the systems on K'Shona.

I spent the rest of the night checking systems and my suspicions were confirmed when minor and apparently random systems failures began to occur. They were symptomatic of the early stages of the problems reported on the IKV Ruthless. The evidence reminded me of an infection and unchecked I realised, the 'infection' could spread to the central computer core. If that happened all the security systems on the base would crash. Fortunately, the weapons systems were linked to a separate system but the damage done to the IKV Ruthless indicated that the 'infection' spread rapidly. In addition, as we had yet to identify the individual or individuals who were behind recent events, I could not be certain that they were not in a position to release more nanites into the weapons and life support systems.

I decided that I had two options, I could either flood the system with a sterilizing gas which would destroy the nanites or I could develop a biological virus which would target only the nanites. I knew I would need medical expertise to find the most effective means of destroying the nanites and so contacted Datira Loydan and together we worked both options and decided upon the second option - Loydan reminded me that we had infected people and systems and we needed a solution that could deal with both.

After 16 hours of intensive work, Datira pronounced herself ready and advised me that she had used the genetic specific virus which had ultimately killed Amac2 as the foundation for her virus. We carried out tests on captured nanites and in all cases none of the creatures survived exposure, our next step was to use the virus on certain minor systems. Our sense of urgency was reinforced by the number of systems failures being reported - Commander Kehoaz reported that she had lost forcefields in one detention block and had had to transfer the prisoners to another section within the main facility. We therefore agreed to test the virus on the detention facilities systems - the results

However, Datira has told me that she will have to continue her work as the nanites appear to be mutating and whilst the computer systems on K'Shona and in the fleet are operational again, infected individuals are not responding to treatment. She will therefore transport to the Ruthless and continue her work. Nanites have been used in medical treatment for some time and she therefore feels that she would like to contact a scientist currently working on the Homeworld who has developed a new strain of nanite. Datira thinks it may be possible to genetically 'reprogram' these nanites to act as 'antibodies' which would seek out and destroy all foreign organisms and then revert to an inert state.

I have had to leave her to her work as Commander Kehoaz has signaled that her interrogation has begun to yield significant results and she has asked me to join her.



M'Ress has finally revealed the name of his controller - Dav'had, one of Gowron's most trusted advisers. It is now clear how the assassin got so close to Gowron but Dav'had has departed for the Homeworld and it is imperative that I follow him. However, I have asked several of my officers to remain here and help to ensure the security of K'Shona. I have located the external control device Dav'had used to control M'Ress but it is badly damaged and beyond repair. I have been able to deduce that it must have been assembled from component parts brought to K'Shona with other bone fide shipments. However, when M'Ress was taken into custody Dav'had had little time to make his

escape and could not disassemble it in time and take it with him and thus had to resort to destroying it. Metallurgical tests and other analyses have established that the 'wreckage' is the control device but my people think it is unlikely that they will be able to tell me how it worked. Cmdr. Koryn Vor'Qis reports he has recovered from his phaser wound and has been "in cahoots" with Capt. K'Lay Chang of Global Security. The missions were kept secret and are classified. Koryn has left command of Internal Intelligence and turned this elite group over to Cmdr. Kara Druidh. His activities are being monitored by GS and CCC. He has returned to mercenary work for the Klingon Empire, against a possible threat that will be made known in time. He has been discrete in his missions. After sedating a replica of Commander Koryn Vor'Qis so that it could be exchanged with the real officer, BullG took the clone to the officer mess on Starbase K'Shona until such time as he and Borg K'mpec were able to effect the switch. This done the officers spent some time amusing themselves until the Chang's Revenge arrived at which time they transported to the ship. He has now resumed his normal duties so that no one was aware of what had transpired. Borg has been practicing his skills with the bat'leth preparing for a forthcoming tournament. However, he received orders to assist in the substitution of Commander Vor'Qis with a clone. Enlisting the help of a fellow officer, he duly did this and escorted the Commander to the offices of Global Security and returned for the clone. Although the assignment was not easy, it was duly completed and Borg delivered the clone to Commander Vor'Qis's quarters. He then used a holographic image of himself to distract observers into thinking he had left and after activating forcefields in these quarters, he concealed himself to await developments. He reports that a chameloid entered and killed the clone but Borg successfully detained the chameloid and this individual has now been transferred to the G.S. Brig

IMPERIAL SECURITY - wo'Hung: LCdr. Ka'at Jo'El reports: Prior to our departure for Kamato I assembled a number of security teams to set up POW camps on Kamato during and after the invasion. En route to Kamato we came across two fleeing IKS K-22's which we engaged, destroying one and disabling the other, which was blown up by its crew. Renegades or not, they were Klingons and it was an honor to fight them. Their heading was 239-331, suggesting they might have been heading to Baker's Dozen or beyond to Klingon space. Our captain and First Officer were killed and the ship sustained moderate damage. I have taken command; our maximum speed is down to Warp 6.3, delaying our arrival at Kamato. I renamed the frigate L-42b to IKV VINDICATOR



and plan to remain in command. After receiving Col. Mardan's orders, we went into Kamato orbit, decloaked and opened fire at primary targets. All their starbase operations were severely crippled after the attack. We used modified shuttles to put them out of operation completely. The few ships that left the starbases were dealt with by Mardan's ships. We lost two shuttles to enemy fire and sustained a large number of hits. We started attacking defense centres and sensor arrays at 01.00 hours. Destroyed main sensor array and the rest within the hour. Following, all secondary targets were attacked and disabled; meanwhile we suppressed any repair attempts of primary targets. After Code Green I started to set up POW camps in Alpha and Beta sectors. First prisoners arrived Hovjaj 908.26. Some of the civilian population are being put to work in the POW building and others have been sent to the Diridium and Hadenium mines. There was a negligible amount of Dilithium and a small amount of Penta Crystals in the wreck of a Federation freighter that crash-landed there some 8 years ago. Crosschecks with computer files did not reveal the point of origins of the crystals. The ship cannot be identified due to its small fragments; at least three other ships of the same type were lost in this region in the same period. Perhaps one of our operatives on Earth can investigate to help distinguish the vessel carrying the crystals from the others. Last report to Colonel Mardan was that all five planned POW camps were set up and processing prisoners. We can expect sabotage actions as well as some attacks from outside from small groups trying to free prisoners. Approximately 20 escaped and security has been stepped up significantly. **PERSONNEL REPORT:** Lt. Kambei Tazman accepted the position of I.S. XO. Lt. Kruge Kronsei: assigned to patrol the Romulan/Triangle border in his D-32 IKV SWIFT JUSTICE to prevent Romulan interference with Kamato operations, and reports no activities. He reported a Ferengi ship coming from Romulan space, headed for Colil V. He boarded and questioned the Captain, a silly fat Ferengi called Aminn, who admitted being forced to go to Colil V to bring back a Romulan operative. The Roms were holding his crew to insure he would do the job. The Roms aboard Aminn's vessel were captured soon afterward. Using the mindsifter on the Roms Kruge learned they planned to take out all Klingon listening posts between Gibraltar and Arris as a prelude to an invasion. Kruge tried to warn the listening post, but they had to get to the Romulan operative to find out what they were planning. Kruge convinced the Ferengi to continue to Colil V, to meet with the Rom operative, called Durann, who was a shapeshifter. After seizing him he found out he had gassed the personnel of the listening posts. were highly satisfactory and armed with these I obtained permission to use the virus on all security systems. I have now checked each system and they are now clean - the nanites within are

I am preparing the Vindicator to assist Kruge should necessary able to reactivate the outposts. Lt. K'oron K'liaz has requested to return to ship duty to take command of a ship, the IKV EXECUTOR. RESERVE STATUS: K'nit B'nzaII, K'shin Hidan-P'Qer. Currently unassigned: Kletas Pazharn, K'hlagh Serad, Lt. Wargrave. Status report on the IKV BLACK FLEET: The former I.S. flagship is at Starbase K'SHONA being refitted to guidelines of Cmdr. K'nit, who will assume command of the vessel after his leave, to search for Penta crystals.



GLOBAL SECURITY:- (qo' Hung): Capt. K'Lay Chang reports: We are doing our best to control the nanite problem, a task made easier now that we know where they came from and can attack them at the source. NI Commander Kara Druidh has learned the names of the traitors on the High Council on Qo'noS responsible for the clones and their accompanying nanite parasites; she has untangled much of the political motivation behind the treason. Her experts have devised a possible method of purging both biological and computer systems of nanite infestations and are field-testing it now. We needed the IKV BARA KUDA' and Sarena Zu-Merz and her medical expertise, so she was removed from stasis and injected with an experimental strain of hunter/killer nanites programmed to wage internal war against those already infesting her body. Not a permanent cure, merely a stopgap measure to get her back on her feet, hoping to buy time until something permanent could be found. Sarena survived the procedure; the unborn son she carried did not. She has returned to Kamato to carry out her Medical Ops duties there and mourn her loss as best she can. A high price to pay for her dedication to duty. Ju'Ngha Chang and the IKV GORKON'S REDEMPTION have completely destroyed the Romulan operated cloning facility that K'wen Trekkon discovered on Kratar. Once Khey'Ra's personnel destroy the second facility the nanites should be eliminated with their clone hosts. Khorghan Ghlanx has negotiated for several privateer ship captains to aid us in the raid on the NEMESIS, and has added a number of Theravul to the IKV GLORY SEEKER's crew, saying they are more trustworthy than defecting Roms or Rom fusions. Whether it is trust or the device planted in Theravul brains that can be detonated at the first sign of betrayal is, to me, a questionable point. But I will trust Khorghan's judgement now as he has not failed me. He has arrived on schedule to rendezvous with K'mar Kurka on the IKV QAPLAJATLH, and Jacen Kas-Chang and K'wen Trekkon on the IKV DEATH BIRD. K'mar Kurka engaged and destroyed a Federation freighter en route to the rendezvous point, their last communication blaming the attack on a Romulan ship. True enough since his Rom Warbird was taken as prize in battle. Khorghan's privateers have created the same havoc, giving a false impression of Rom aggression along the border. The scene is thus set, the players in place. Soon we will strike, and the Federation technology unfairly denied us will be ours. All that mars my joy at this anticipated achievement is the knowledge that neither Koryn Vor'QiS nor Thought Admiral Keel K'ta-ri will be here to see it. We have allowed Koryn's would-be shape changing assassin, captured by Kara and I, to think he has succeeded in his deadly assignment, thus giving Koryn the freedom and anonymity he says he needs to complete a mission on his own. In his usual enigmatic manner he left no details and no trace as he and the IKV HAJ QIB disappeared from sensors. Thought Admiral Keel has "disappeared" as well, along with the IKV RUTHLESS and a squadron of GS escort ships into a dark nebula, after a fire fight with an unknown enemy, and as far as anyone else knows is Missing in Action. As the only

not to say, is that The One has embarked on a secret assignment for the Emperor, and one no one may know the details lest lives and the mission itself be jeopardized. Since no one asked me this question directly, I have not been forced to lie, and have departed with Capt. Katalyia K'Tore-Jiraal on her warp shuttle's shakedown cruise to avoid compromising my position and Keel's hidden truth. If I am fortunate, by the time Katalyia and I return to K'SHONA the investigation will have concluded, or at least passed me by. I must be careful what I wish for. Katalyia's shuttle, SILENT SHADOW, has suffered an unexplained computer failure, its navigational systems shut down completely. We are blind and at a dead stop and I haven't a clue what's wrong. It looks like the investigation I so feared could be colder than the vacuum of space before anyone finds us, and I may take Keel's secret to the Black Fleet along with me...

ADDENDUM. Anonymous tape sent to KSF Command. Top secret description of contents now follows. Deep within the nebula hangs a small, cloaked Bird of Prey. It is captained by a leonine elderly Klingon and crewed by his four sons, the remnants of a once proud family. The Captain sits there silently, waiting, eyes convex lenses of ebony. The atmosphere is tense with anticipation. Suddenly, the IKV RUTHLESS appears, travelling at speed. The Captain gives an almost imperceptible hand signal and a single blast is aimed at the ship. His obsidian eyes are illuminated with streaks of orange and yellow as the target explodes and burns, otherwise, he is impassive. A slow, humourless smile spreads across the elderly Klingons face showing his yellow pointed teeth. He had lived beyond his years for this moment. His losses of land, sons and honour had been avenged and he could finally enter the Black Fleet with pride. The ship recloaked and vanished, leaving nothing but shrapnel and empty space. NEMESIS MISSION - Jacen Kas-Chang reports joining the IKV DEATH BIRD after returning from the Homeworld where he had undergone the joining ritual with the House of Chang. He briefed K'wen Trekkon, Captain of the Death Bird: "The facility is located in a system designated Omega 19D deep in the heart of the Federation. We'll fly in under cloak and locate suitable transport sites and the best escape routes. The system houses a secret research facility, which contains an experimental Galaxy Class Starship, the USS NEMESIS. It contains a cloaking device that can phase the ship, with Biowarp drive and advanced shielding. We are going to steal the blueprints." Kwen toggled the comm unit by her side and gave orders to set course. The Death Bird dropped out of warp; arriving at the research facility ten minutes after sailing into the system, Kwen ordered scanning to begin with reports in one hour. The scans were clear. Jacen told her the base had minimal security with two starships to defend it, so StarFleet hoped the system would go unnoticed. On the 20th of each month most personnel go for shore leave; it takes one and one half days for the relief crew to arrive. The Romulan crew members on Jacen's ship would go along with Jacen. "That way the Federation thinks the Romulans attacked, and let the issue drop because Federation cloaking devices are banned by the treaty." When the scans were completed, K'wen ordered the Helm to set course back to K'SHONA. Lt. Khey'Ra Druidh reports her journey to Cardassia was without incident. She had studied maps of the First city of Cardassia and the Science lab of the Obsidian Order. On arrival and in disguise, she beamed down to the old town of the first city and made her way to the Science Station with forged ID documents. There she struck up a conversation with a resident Cardassian scientist who worked in one of the top secret labs where she needed to go. She told him she was temporarily assigned to the station to cover for Dr. Jayala who was on a mission to the 13th planet. The scientist did not question her; he took the lead and entered the access codes to the lab. Khey'Ra entered and using the password for the computer she downloaded all the information

on the cloaking device on the tiny computer she had designed for the mission. She took some computer chips which were needed to construct the device. She was able to leave the lab and return to the beaming point without problems. Back on the ship she learned she needed to return to the IKV QIH telmey as soon as possible. She set course for Klingon space with no time to process the captured information. Her surgeon was waiting to reverse her surgical alteration. Her First Officer told her they had been ordered to set course for Kratara, an uninhabited planet on the edge of the Neutral Zone to investigate the cloning facility discovered by K'wen Trekkon-B'nzall, and to check ship and crew for all types of nanites. Then she set course for Kratara. She and two of the crew beamed down to the location of the cloning facility. The compound was deserted. Only a few Romulan guards and scientists were present. They soon defeated the guards. She decided to take the scientists and guards to K'SHONA for further interrogation; she checked them for nanites and found none. She transferred all computer records to the QIH Telmey's databanks. Returning to her ship, she received a transmission from Lt. Ju'Nghah, telling her he was under orders to destroy the facility. She then received orders from Starbase K'SHONA to contact Cmdr. Arizhel Kehoaz for the location of another cloning facility, also close to the Neutral Zone, to investigate and destroy it. It was staffed by clones from Romulan genetic material. Khey'Ra sent a team to investigate the compound and destroy the clones. All computer records were transferred to the ship. She then gave orders to Apprentice Gunner Kachwad to destroy the facility. Ensuring that no Klingon genetic material remained, she set course for K'SHONA. Khen'Ra reports: "I am pleased to report that all known clones have been killed and that the cloning facilities have been fully investigated and completely destroyed...after our return to K'SHONA I still have to process all accumulated data (cloaking device and clones), have a look at the tissue samples, interrogate the Romulans and make sure there are no more nanites on board the Cardassian ship." Ens. Kachwad tai Nichp't reports: My mission was simple: a Romulan cloning facility had been discovered and we were ordered to destroy it. As part of my apprenticeship I was taking the shot--do you expect the Rommies to just sit there while I blow the thing to smithereens? There was no trouble getting to the destination; after getting there I just had to lock on and wait to be told to fire. The various sounds over the next few minutes went something like this: ZAP! KABOOM!! "Captain, it's the Romulans!" "WHERE?" "BEHIND US!" "What the--!" followed by various Romulan swear words. To my surprise I wasn't replaced by a qualified gunner. I was ordered to aim for the engines and weapons systems. The Romulans returned fire luckily only inflicting minor damage to the shields. I rapidly threw as much disrupter fire back as possible. The ship was hailed with the Romulans generally telling us to surrender. With amazing luck they had been completely disabled. Qapla'! After some good old destruction work we safely returned on course. LCdr Hurgh sutai-M'Mer (NPC) took command of the IKV COLD REVENGE to go the the assistance of Adm. K'Zhen for the Kamato invasion. Arriving, he sighted the IKV Bara Kuda' in place, but before he was near the planet, Gorn ships were detected, and the Cold Revenge was obliged to engage them in combat to prevent their interference with the takeover. Although outgunned and outnumbered, Hurgh stood his ground. COVERT MILITARY COMMAND - (vangmey pegh ra'ghom): Fleet Admiral K'Zhen Septar-Zu-Merz, commanding the IKV SHADOW STRIKER, led the CMC fleet into the battle for Kamato, employing the L-42b's awesome firepower to bombard specified targets on the planet while smaller ships were instructed to prevent any of Kamato's defense vessels from interfering. Surface weapons installations and other defense Targets were successfully eliminated, preparing the way for Col. Mardan's Marine forces to beam down for the takeover. LCdr. Khen K'with, Chief Engineer for the Shadow Striker, operated

the shield variable random frequency oscillator when we began taking fire. A heavy hit to the port plasma conduit leading to the port nacelle was quickly held by an emergency force field patch, and crews were dispatched to start repairs. Shunting most of the plasma through secondary systems made the helm sluggish. To give the enemy similar problems, Khen charged some of the plasma with heavy sub-atomics and vented it, making them think we were hurt worse, and throwing off most sensors, adjusting our sensors to compensate. Shield power was shifted to the weakened area and the Structural Integrity Field was designated to distribute hits more evenly through the ship, giving us a short-term edge. The available power during lower warp output during battle was shunted into the main deflector dish for a power burst linked to our forward disruptor. The resulting blast was rather spectacular, though not leaving much in the way of captives for questioning. LCdr. Kain Kentoo reports the IKV Black Death and the IKV Death Hawk took up positions adjacent to the IKV Shadow Striker to prevent attack on the KSF flagship. CMC SHADOW SQUADRON commanded by Cmdr. Zhul Zhod assisted in orbital bombardment of the planet Kamato prior to depositing marine personnel and equipment to the planet surface. BLACK WIDOW SQUADRON provided support for the IKV SHADOW STRIKER, and also dispatched a K-22 to patrol the Neutral zone against intervention. SILENT STORM Squadron provided rear support for the Shadow Striker. Borg K'mpec was ordered to patrol the Neutral Zone. CMC/MOC was ordered to prepare for treatment of marine forces injured during the invasion. CMC logistics was ordered to transport POW's from Kamato to the Shadow Striker and maintain supply lines. CMC marine forces beamed down to Kamato to establish an outward perimeter for IMC forces during the Marine invasion. Lt. Borg K'Mpec with the IKV STARBURST DISPACER BEAST patrolling the neutral zone reported sighting several large Gorn destroyers and a H45 G'hrraga Class XII heavy cruiser. Two squadrons of K-22 scouts in addition to one D-18 destroyer and one D-7 battle cruiser joined the patrol. Lt. Kelani Gharjak reports completing a device to detect the energy signature of any ship using the Interphase Generator, adapting it to photon torpedos to allow them to home in on such ships. A saboteur attempting to damage another torpedo was caught in the weapons bay of the Shadow Striker by Kelani; he resisted capture and had to be killed.

Her aide is attempting to find out where he came from. Taking command of a K-22, she took three members of her house for the crew, including Torg as 1st officer and her cousin Tanin as Engineer. The shakedown cruise assignment was to patrol the neutral zone. crew performed well, despite some contention among the crew. A quick battle tournament settled the issue. Several Gorn ships crossed the neutral zone, and the ship went into battle. Lt. Kor Vren Kurzark has taken command of a ship and assembled a crew, reporting on each of them. The ship received its baptism during the battle of Kamato. He named his ship the IKV DEATH HAWK. Lt. Jg. K'tar tai Kega took command of a K-22 scout and was sent to assist the patrol of the Neutral Zone. It experienced a burst plasma coil which severely injured the moral officer. Repairs were made quickly and they arrived at the Neutral zone. Several Gorn naval vessels of unknown class crossed the zone, and the ship engaged them with the rest of the patrol ships. I have given the order to terminate the FKM terrorists in the government building. request permission to beam the prisoners aboard the IKV Shadowstriker. The Commotion inside the building has forced the military to commit themselves by storming the building. Hidden surveillance cameras show what we had expected, confusion. The Military commander is requesting more troops to be committed in the search for the missing officials, as they are not amongst the dead. There seems to be small pockets of resistance within the city itself but my major concerns have been addressed admirably by the invasion troops.


Additional

reports that after surgery and the loss of her infant son, she returned to Kamato to receive incoming casualties. She feels that all lives should be saved, including those of the enemy, but has ordered her XO to follow Admiral K'Zhen's orders to render aid only to our own soldiers. She arrived back on the IKV BARA KUDA' to find the department virtually falling apart. They had lost several high-ranking officers and soldiers. She ordered all available personnel with medical training to the Bara Kuda' to help with triage, sending the marine medics to work in the morgue.

KLINGON EMBASSY - tlhIngan rIvSo': LCdr. Krysythe sutai-Ka'el zi reports that all members of the Embassy have been contacted; she has chosen Lt. Koloth sutai-K'Tama as her XO. Lt. K'Legion Jen-A Kluge and Ambassador Krowgon Drek'mar have joined the Embassy staff. A summary of a report from Lt. Chani Vawter-Draclon on the planet THISISIT follows: There are 3 population groups, the most important being the warriors, possibly a 6th of the population, who are renegade Klingons. The last group, 1/2 of the population are crafts and tradesmen, such as farmers, woodworkers, weavers, teachers, healers, tinkers, artists, etc. who should be kept alive. Defenses: Every 3rd month provisions are brought to the scientists by an Oberth Class starship, the USS Grissom, NCC-59314. Recommend we avoid that month. This Article contains information on how to get very professional photographs of yourself in your Klingon Garb.

Step 1

You must locate the different schools in your area. By this we mean Sixth Form colleges, Art Schools, and even Universities. What you are looking for is a student or a class full of students that need a new subject.

Step 2

Get in contact with whoever is in charge of the art dept. Some Art Depts have Photographic courses and some modules will specialise in Portraiture. This is what you are looking for. Get in contact with the teacher of this class and show them photos of yourself in Costume.

Step 3

Once all the talk is over and the teacher agrees that this would be something different for the students, you must take one thing into consideration. ALL Photographers take lots of photos and they keep the negatives. For you, this is not good. This is how they make their money. They take your picture, give you the photos and keep the negatives for themselves so you have to go back to them for reprints. You might want to ask the teacher who his best student is. Approach them and explain what you and their class will be doing soon. You may compliment the student by telling them you asked for the best in the class to take some photos of you so that you can have your own set of Negatives, so you can reproduce some

prints later at your local lab. This means you will purchase the film or give the student money for the undeveloped film. If the student does not seem thrilled about the idea, you may want to try bribing them by offering to buy their film and let them borrow the negatives later to make prints from for their own portfolio.

Hint

You may wish to go with Black and White photos for several reasons. They tend to look better and show us in a better Klingon light, colour tends to make you look softer. B/W also Photocopies better than colour and will be used in Newspapers more easily. B/W also hides any colour imperfections in your make up and the change of colour between your skin and the headpiece.

Now go out and call some of those schools and lets see our Klingons in a good light.





